

QCCN update to share for the upcoming I&T network.

- As you may already know, as of October 2023, there is a mandatory 1-hour pre-recorded QCCN Speech and Language Training for educators who meet both criteria:
 - Criteria 1: educators who are currently supporting infant, toddler, and/or preschool age group in Niagara **and**
 - Criteria 2: educators who have completed the QCCN Reflective Practice Institute in the past (between November 2015 and August 2023).

- For this training specifically, Supervisors are asked to register their staff team that meet criteria 1 and 2 from above. Individual registrations by educators are not accepted during this time.

- Once this registration is submitted, each participant will receive a confirmation email with links to the training via Zoom, the Speech and Language documents, and QCCN Training Evaluation. Please ensure the email addresses are correct upon registration.

- Centres are welcome to complete this mandatory training as a staff team during staff meetings or participants can complete it at their own pace and schedule. If completing it as a team and using one log-in, please keep a list of who completed the webinar training and send the list to the QCCN Coordinator. Kindly note, the QCCN Training Evaluation is individually completed. Both components are required to be completed (1-hour webinar training and QCCN Training Evaluation) in order to receive a certificate.

- Please note the cut-off date for the previous Speech and Language documents (updated October 2020) will be February 28, 2024. Centres will have until October 21, 2024 for their educators to complete the QCCN Speech and Language Webinar Module Training.

- School age educators who also support infant, toddler, and/or preschool age groups are welcome to complete this training along with individuals from admin team.
