
Early Years Careers



The ECE / CDP career path is ideal for students who are interested in:

- ✓ working with young children from birth up to age 12
- ✓ being part of team of educators working to create dynamic early learning environments
- creating and leading quality indoor and outdoor programming
- ✓ ongoing professional development and learning
- ✓ working in a career that is in very high demand

Child Development Practitioner Apprenticeship

- Approximately 3 to 4 years to complete
- Complete 750 hours of in-class training at an approved Ontario College as set out in the Curriculum Training Standard
- Complete 5280 hours of on-the-job training and complete the competencies as set in the Apprenticeship training Standard Log Book
- "earn while you learn" approach -Students are funded by the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skill Development (MLITSD).
- 3 to 4 college bridging courses to become an ECE

For both options students require an OSSD to apply

ECEs must register with the College of ECEs in order to work in Ontario

Early Childhood Educator

- 2 year course available at most community colleges in Ontario
- In-person and virtual learning options exist
- A combination of in-class teaching and 600 hours of practical field placement experience (unpaid)
- College tuition fees apply
