The position will begin Tuesday May 21 and end Monday July 15, 2024; however, a flexible start date is possible. Consideration for a blend of in person and remote work is possible.

The successful candidate will have the following qualifications and skills:

- Enrolled or graduated as a full-time student in a post-secondary program of studies related to early learning and child care. Must be a Canadian Citizen between the ages of 15 and 30 years old.
- Ability to work independently with initiative and innovation in an efficient and timely manner.
