

# **Reflective Practice Network Meeting Minutes**

Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2015 5:00 to 7:00 pm, ECCDC, Community Board Room

### 1. Welcomes and Introductions

# 2. Acceptance of Minutes from last meeting

# 3. Acceptance of the Agenda

The agenda was accepted with no changes

#### 4. Training/Network Development Activity

- *Higher Order Thinking Prompts* activity led by Shari Hill. Thanks to Shari for leading this activity.
  - O Shari led a role play activity with two volunteers who had an opportunity to Mess About with an infant and toddler kit, containing loose parts, while Shari asked them questions utilizing the Higher Order Thinking Prompts. Copies of the Higher Order Thinking Prompts were circulated and participants were invited to observe the interactions. Key points included; asking to join the play, not showing the children what to do, the children will engage you in the play, the use of developmentally appropriate language, using questions to draw out answers and creative play, don't ask questions that you know the answer to, gear the questions to what is happening, use open ended questions, ask 'what are you thinking' etc.
  - Examples of how centres have used the Higher Order Thinking prompts include, posting the questions in classroom to prompt use of the questions, prompts in word bubbles at activity centres for use and ease of access.

  - Participants viewed video 1; 'What is it' and video 2; 'relationships. This was followed by a discussion regarding values and dispositions, enabling children to move materials around the classroom and encouraging the children to return items when play is finished, a discussion regarding the emergent journey, the QCCN journey, and participants linked the discussion to practice.

#### 5. Round Table Updates and Discussion by organization

 One participant shared that a child found a seed at lunch time and planted it; it is now sprouting 4 weeks later. The participant who shared this and noted that they didn't realize what she was doing in the moment, as they just did it, but now has thought about the emergent aspect of the activity as it was done in the moment.

- o Finding the time to support the children.
- Another participant shared that a spider was found crawling across the floor and educators involved the children in creating their own spider, then discussed where it would live and the children built a web to continue the learning.
- A student on placement shared that the children had found some ants. A baby food
  jar with holes in the top was brought out to put the ants in, as the children thought
  that the ants were hungry. Bananas were added and they started to change colour. A
  conversation regarding this evolved.
- An ECCDC member of staff shared that, in the past insect kits were in the library for the entire summer however, since the move to emergent practices, the kits are now being borrowed during the summer months and not just the spring.
- 6. Highlight Naturalized Playspaces webpage on the ECCDC website followed by a discussion regarding rethinking play spaces.
  - The Naturalized Playspaces webpage link, on the ECCDC website, was highlighted and participants had an opportunity to view the categories. They were encouraged to spend some time having a look around it individually.
  - Participants were asked if they would you like to include Naturalized Playspaces as an agenda item for discussion at future reflective practice network meetings.
     Participants will look at the website page and any additions to the webpages will be highlighted at future network meetings.

#### 7. Continuous Professional Learning Discussion

- Support for CPL within daily practice
- Suggestions for further support regarding CPL
- Completion of online module in a computer lab
  - Participants were asked for feedback regarding how the ECCDC can support educators with CPL and if they would like it to be a standing agenda item. Participants felt that educators were confused and a little overwhelmed; however once they start the process it would be less daunting.

#### 8. Development of Resources available at the ECCDC

- Discussion regarding resources in the lending library, the role of the Die cut presses in the future etc.
  - The ECCDC is reviewing the resources in the lending library and as a result an online survey was sent to all members. As a follow up to this, a conversation café will be held on April 1, 2015 6.30-7.30pm, for more in depth discussions to take place regarding the needs of the users of the kits and the content in the future. A light supper will be served and all are invited to attend. Participants were asked to book if they plan to attend to ensure sufficient catering.
  - Participants were asked about the relevance of the Die cuts to their practice and if they use them, in what capacity. Participants use them in the following ways; as loose parts for the creative shelf, as conversation starters and for labels on bulletin boards.
