NEW! Nurturing Children's Connections to Nature Award

This award category honours the outstanding efforts of a Registered Early Childhood Educator (RECE) who models professionalism and excellence in applying Ontario's Early Learning Framework How Does Learning Happen? in his or her daily work. This award is sponsored by Bienenstock Natural Playgrounds and the Early Childhood Community Development Centre.

Margaret Hamilton Student Award Winner

Presented by the Niagara College Early Childhood Education program, this award commends a graduating student who has excelled in both academics and field placements and who is likely to make a major contribution to the early learning and child care profession during the course of his or her career.

Brock Bachelor of Early Childhood Education Outstanding Student Award Winner

Presented by Brock University's Bachelor of Early Childhood Education program, this award prizes a student in his or her final year of studies who best demonstrates the standards of practice and ethics of care in both academic pursuits and contributions to the early childhood community.

Emergent Literacy Award


