National Child Day

November 20 is recognized as National Child Day in Canada. This special day honours our country's commitment to upholding the rights of children and two historic events: the 1959 signing of the United Nations Declaration of the Rights of the Child and the adoption of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) in 1989.

This year is the 30th anniversary of Canada's ratification of the UNCRC. It is an opportunity to recognize the rights of all children, while also acknowledging the unique rights of First Nations, Métis, and Inuit children.

The theme for National Child Day 2021 is #8MillionStrong in honour of the power and resilience of all 8 million kids in Canada and their right to survive and thrive (Children First Canada).
