Quality Child Care Niagara Expectations for Tools and Resources

Quality Child Care Niagara (QCCN) is a *mandatory* Quality Initiative Program of Service Agreements with Niagara Region Children's Services, which includes **QCCN Tools and Resources**, **QCCN Training**, and **QCCN Support Visits**.

Tools and Resources

The following resources and tools are *mandatory* components to be completed:

- **DISC Preschool Screen (DPS)** within 4-6 weeks of the child's start date and completed for every child with consent from the family (**annually**).
 - Consent form, DPS booklets, and DPS Tracking Sheet
- Speech & Language Referral Checklist within 6-8 weeks of the child's start date and completed for every child with consent from the family (annually).
 - Consent form, Speech & Language Referral Checklists, and Speech & Language Tracking Sheets
- Behaviour Children's Actions Relationships and Emotions (C.A.R.E.) Checklist as needed over a 20-day period with consent from the family (as needed).
 - Consent form and Behaviour C.A.R.E. Checklist
- QCCN Monthly Statistical Reports submitted by the 15th of each month and print hard copy or save electronically (monthly).

The following resources and tools are *encouraged* components to be completed as needed:

- Program Profile
- Caregiver Interaction Scale
- Family Engagement Strategies
- Environmental Rating Scales, Environment Rating Scales Feedback Forms and Resource and Inventory Lists

QCCN Speech and Language Module Training for *all* Educators – *Ends October 2024*

Since **October 23, 2023** registration has been open for the new *mandatory* QCCN Speech and Language Module training. Centres have until **October 21, 2024** to ensure all educators who meet both criteria (listed below) complete this mandatory training.

The pre-recorded webinar module is approximately an hour in length and includes training on the new Niagara Children's Centre Online Referral Portal and updated Checklists, Referral Process, and documents. *Please note*, the cut-off date for the previous Speech and Language documents (updated October 2020) was February 28, 2023.

What are the criteria?

This training is *mandatory* for staff who meet **both** the following criteria:

- a) Educators currently supporting infant, toddler, and/or preschool programs in Niagara; and
- b) Educators who have completed the QCCN Reflective Practice Institute in the past (between November 2015 and August 2023).

If you meet **both** criteria from above, then this QCCN Speech and Language Webinar Training Module is **mandatory** for you.

Who submits the registrations?

We ask that **Supervisors** register all team members who meet the above criteria. Registrations made by individual staff members cannot be accepted at this time. Supervisors, **click here** to register your staff.
